2. 主持人读出或展示以下出自 Dato' Jega 关乎《天天孝亲》（HONOUR OUR PARENTS EVERYDAY 简称 HOPE）活动的叮咛。然后，对在中心促进此活动的工作进行讨论。
【脑激荡】

July 2016: SCA Study Circle

Facilitators Notes:

Distribute the questionnaire to participants. Allow 10 minutes to complete the questionnaire.

Play the video 'The Waiters' Mom' (5:22 min). <https://youtu.be/WK5NYCekCVM>

1. Ask the participants to share their thoughts and learnings from the exercise. They may share any of their response(s) from the questionnaire. 【Sequential narration】
2. Facilitator to read out/show the following message from Dato' Jega on HONOUR OUR PARENTS EVERYDAY (HOPE) program, then brainstorm on what the centre can do to promote HOPE. 【Brainstorm】

Today they say is Mother's day. NO! NO! NO!

Every day is Mother's day. Every mother who prays to God everyday thanking God for the son or daughter she has as a gift of God ... THAT IS MOTHER'S DAY. That is the essence of HOPE Agenda... HONOUR OUR PARENTS EVERYDAY...

Once a year Mother's or Father's day only benefits the shopkeepers... AND is a Western Tradition.

May every mother be exalted every day. If your mother is not staying with you for you to seek her blessing everyday... Then at least call her everyday... Just one minute and ask how she is and tell her you Love her.

The same applies to father.
